WHEREAS, College Republicans is requesting funding;


**THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE STUDENT CONGRESS OF THE

Speaker Zach De La Rosa and members of the 93rd Student Congress:

I have decided to veto SCB 93-040 for the following reasons:

- 1) The expectation for the College Republicans to raise \$15,000 for a speaking event is without precedent. While the College Republicans would have until the end of the year to repay the money, the planned date of the event is only nine days away. Expecting the group to raise such a large dollar amount for a speaker mostly ex post facto is unrealistic and sets a precedent that I find to be unacceptable.
- 2) The College Republicans have expressed a desire to re-request funds for a different event, unencumbered by the stipulations of this particular bill.

For the reasons above, I am vetoing this bill in order to preserve the group's opportunity to host a successful event this semester.

I thank the members of the 93rd Student Congress for working hard to enable student groups to host events and speakers on campus. However, the fundraising/cash split required by this bill did not enable the College Republicans to host this event in a financially responsible manner. I feel that the College Republicans should have a new opportunity to come to the Finance Committee and to Student Congress to request funds.
